

Unofficial Transcripts or Grade Reports

Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) has been flagged by the Department of Education for "Unusual Enrollment History (UEH)."

Since your evaluation for admission has concluded, you will need to provide unofficial transcripts or grade reports for each relevant institution.

You have been notified via email which schools will require an unofficial transcript or grade report. You can review your entire FSA history via NSLDS Student Access.

Once your unofficial transcripts or grade reports have been reviewed:

- ➤ If you received academic credit(s) at each institution, then you will receive an email confirmation of your FSA eligibility.
- ➤ If you did not earn academic credit(s), you will be contacted by our office requesting additional information.

<u>Note</u>: CSU cannot waive the UEH document requirement. If your prior school(s) have placed financial hold(s) on your student account(s), you may be required to clear the hold(s) before any records are released.
